

Introduction

CHEP 2007 is weeks away. The conference dates are Sunday, September 2 – Friday, September 7. We remind you that there will also be a WLCG meeting on Saturday, September 1 and Sunday, September 2.

The conference fees are \$650 CDN. This price includes full conference participation, proceedings, welcome drink on Sunday September 2nd, three lunches, conference banquet on Wednesday September 5th and all coffee breaks. The fee for the WLCG meeting is \$90 and includes coffee breaks and two lunches.

If you intend to stay at one of the two conference hotels, we highly recommend that you book as soon as possible as there are only a limited number of rooms.

As the conference is being held over the last long weekend in the summer, we highly recommend you make your travel arrangements as soon as possible. The number of flights between Victoria and Vancouver/Seattle are limited. There may be a large demand to leave in the early afternoon of Friday September 7.

The plenary sessions will be in the mornings and the parallel sessions in the afternoons. There will be two poster sessions each lasting 2 days (Mon-Tue and Wed-Thu). We hope to make it possible for the posters to be mounted on the Sunday evening. Two dedicated poster sessions are scheduled for Tue and Wed during the morning coffee breaks. The authors are asked to attend the assigned poster session. Note that the guidelines for the poster size can be found on the CHEP 2007 web site.

The proceedings will be published in the Institute of Physics (IOP) Conference Series. The proceedings will only be available electronically and no paper version will be printed. All contributions (plenary, parallel and poster) are expected to contribute to the proceedings. The papers are due by the end of the conference. A latex template is available on the CHEP 2007 web site. More detailed information on the submission procedure will be posted in August.

Registration will be open for a short period on Friday August 31 (17:00-19:00) and on Saturday, September 1 prior to the WLCG meeting. Registration will be open on Sunday, September 2, from 17:00 until 21:00 and then any time during the conference.
